One of the chief Visegrad Music Team's (originated in 2007) goals has been to support research activity of doctoral students from music departments in Slovak and Czech Republic. The research should be grounded within the field of music psychology, music pedagogy, and should be utilized in music pedagogy and practice. The first conference Theory and Practice of Music Education was held in 2009 from the initiative of Prof. Jaroslav Herden, Faculty of Education, Charles University in Prague. In the years 2012 and 2013 there were organised homonymous conferences in Prague, which met with great acclaim of doctoral students, as well as of elementary and secondary school teachers.

On November 12th – 13th, 2015 we organise a scientific conference. It will be held in cooperation with Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports (CZ) and private school Music Art – Faculty Music School in Prague. Conference aim

The leitmotif of power-point presentations, reports and papers is: "In Support of Pedagogical Practice". The conference is aimed at utilization of music theory and research in music pedagogy and practice of elementary and grammar schools. The challenges which approach educating children in all music activities are welcome. We are glad to accept the contributions which approach music education within the context of aesthetic changes and shifts in children's contemporary music values with regard to educational reform. We also assume to receive critical contributions which include contemporary evaluation of future university music pedagogues' education in Visegrad countries.

A note on the realization

Every thematic field will be led by a chairman, a field specialist. Successively three papers relating to the theme, approved by the conference scientific board, will be presented. Five invited lectures will be presented in the conference hall 081 and in adjoining rooms of the MEYS CZ at a given point in time. They will explain inspirational music activities, methods and forms of work at school. The title of the intended paper, power-point presentation or thematic field which is connected with participant's research interest should be filled in the electronic Application Form. Participants are invited to bring their own notebook and to make posters. For plenary presentations participants have all the necessary

equipment at their disposal. Doctoral students have the prerogative right to present their paper or power-point presentation. The choice of the papers will be approved by the conference scientific board. Papers returned to the board in electronic form will be reviewed and published in the Collection of 2013 Conference Proceedings Theory and Practice of Music Education IV.

Publication:

- 1. Annotations of papers and presentations will be at participants' disposal in written form during the official opening of the conference.
- 2. The Collection of 2015 Conference Proceedings will be published after conference and mailed to the participants by post. It will be distributed to the participants also in electronic form.
- 3. Evaluation of the conference, of its most significant papers and presentations will be published in professional journals Music Education (Hudební výchova, CZ), Muses at School (Múzy v škole, SK) and Ars Inter Culturas (PL).
