Guideliness for technical preparation of the paper

Send the annotations and papers to E-mail address of Mgr. Zuzana Selčanova (*zuzsel@centrum.cz*), the deadline is October 2th, 2015. The paper and annotation should be written in text editor MS Word with the following parameters:

Title of the paper in Czech, Slovak, Polish or English language First name and surname of the author without academic titles

Annotation:

The summary of main ideas of the paper in mother tongue should be written in sentences of minimum 5 – maximum 10 lines.

Key words:

The list of the keywords arranged in alphabetical order should be written **in mother tongue** and separated by a comma.

Title of the paper in English language

Abstract:

The summary of main ideas of the paper **in English** should be written in sentences of minimum 5 – maximum 10 lines

Keywords:

The list of the keywords arranged in alphabetical order should be written **in English** and separated by a comma.

Title and structure of the paper:

Papers should be written in Czech, Slovak, Polish or English language. The paper's extent should be maximum five pages of A4 (including graphs, pictures, tables, bibliography and contact address of the author). Don't add page numbers to the document, use font type Times New Roman, size 12, line single. To highlight important parts of the text **font bold** or *italics* are allowed.

For numbered list you can use the following style:

For indented list use the following style:

Tables, graphs and pictures should be inserted in the text. Be very particular about not exceeding the margins of the document. Bibliography should follow the Bibliographic norm.

Contact address should be listed in the end of the paper (author's first name and surname, academic and scientific degrees, the address of the institution and work place, E-mail address).

You can also add the information whether the contribution is supported by certain grant project.
